



## Chair of the Engineering Associates Registration Board

The Minister for Building and Construction seeks expressions of interest from people wishing to be considered for appointment as Chair of the Engineering Associates Registration Board. Candidates need to have strong governance skills and an engineering background.

Under the Engineering Associates Act 1961, the Board's role is to approve the registration of engineering associates, hear complaints and exercise disciplinary powers. The Board also encourages improved competence and qualification of engineering associates through its voluntary ongoing competency scheme.

The Chair is required to work closely with the registrar at least fortnightly (in part for audit purposes). For this reason, the Chair should be resident in Wellington or able to be in Wellington fortnightly.
